Hi! This is Tommy Thompson. Every month I review a new movie playing at theaters near you. I studied theater and cinema in college before becoming an actor and a director. After retiring from show business, I started to write movie reviews for a local newspaper and Monthly Movie Review was born.

Today we look at the action movie, Bat Dude.



Starring Wayne Bruce, Bat Dude is the story of a superhero who fights crime in a big city. Movie fans might confuse Bat Dude with more famous megahits, but this movie is very different.

Bat Dude and other heroes both fight crime and rescue people. But that is all they have in common. While people usually cheer for other heroes, they think Bat Dude is dangerous. Have you ever ① watched a movie starring Gene Hackman? He was a great movie star who won two Academy Awards: Best Actor for the lead role he played in *The French Connection* (1971) and Best Supporting Actor for playing a bad sheriff in *Unforgiven* (1992). He (②-A) starred in the pioneering disaster film called *The Poseidon Adventure* (1972), a global hit which earned over \$125 million the world over and financially rescued 20th Century Fox. 【 ア 】

Decades have passed and, now, anything related to Gene Hackman must be told in the past tense because, on February 26th, 2025, a dead body was found in his home in Santa Fe, New Mexico. The body was (②-B) identified as the actor's. Also found in the house was another body as well as a dead dog, which were revealed to belong to his wife, Betsy Machiko Arakawa, and one of their three dogs, ③ Zinna.

The police investigated the causes of their deaths, and concluded (②-C) there was no foul play*¹ or accidents (④) a gas leak or carbon monoxide poisoning*². 【 イ 】 They inferred that Hackman, Arakawa and their dog, Zinna, died naturally, and the chronological*³ order of their deaths was suggested as follows: Betsy Arakawa, a famous pianist from Hawaii who was 64 years old at the time, died first, probably on February 12th, 2025. On the morning of that day, she called a private clinic and made an appointment for the afternoon. She didn't show up. Her husband, Gene Hackman, (②-D) was 95 years old and suffering from advanced Alzheimer's*⁴, died next from severe heart disease. The data in his pacemaker recorded his last heartbeat, which occurred on February 18th, 6 days after the day on which Arakawa is supposed to have died. With his advanced dementia*⁵, Hackman must not have understood what was going on around him. It was indicated that at some point after her death, Hackman fell, and was not able to stand up again.

Their dog, Zinna, probably died last. She was shut up in a small pet carrier, for she had been discharged from an animal hospital the day before Arakawa's death. It seems that Arakawa just wanted (⑤) her dog resting in a safe place after the treatment she received at the hospital until she was sure that her dog had fully recovered. Arakawa's death extended the time in the pet carrier, and the dog that she loved and must have wished to live a long and healthy life, eventually died a painful death from starvation and dehydration*⁶. 【 ウ 】 Hackman and Arakawa were said to have been serious dog lovers. All of their three dogs came from animal shelters. Zinna was an Australian kelpie mix*⁷, and the two that
